Dear client,

The protection of your personal data is important to us. According to the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), we are obliged to inform you of the purpose for which our practice collects, stores or forwards data. You can also see from the information what rights you have with regard to data protection.

1. RESPONSIBILITY FOR DATA PROCESSING

2. PURPOSE OF DATA PROCESSING

The data processing is based on legal requirements in order to fulfill the treatment/coaching contract between you and your coach or doctor and the associated obligations.

For this we process your personal data, especially your health data. This includes anamnesis, diagnoses, therapy suggestions and findings, which we or other doctors or coaches collect. For these purposes, other coaches, doctors or psychotherapists with whom you are being treated can also provide us with data (e.g. in doctor's letters).

The collection of health data is a prerequisite for your treatment. If the necessary information is not provided, careful treatment cannot take place.

3. RECIPIENT OF YOUR DATA

We only transfer your personal data to third parties if this is permitted by law or if you have given your consent.

The recipients of your personal data may be other coaches / doctors / psychotherapists, medical associations, health insurance companies, the medical service of health insurance, medical associations and private medical clearing houses.

The transmission takes place predominantly for the purpose of billing the services provided to you, to clarify medical questions and those arising from your insurance relationship. In individual cases, data is transmitted to other authorized recipients.

4. STORAGE YOUR DATA

We only keep your personal data for as long as is necessary to carry out the treatment/coaching.

Due to legal requirements, we are obliged to keep this data at least 10 years after the end of treatment. Other regulations may result in longer retention periods, for example 30 years for X-ray recordings in accordance with paragraph 28 paragraph 3 of the X-ray Ordinance.

5. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to receive information about your personal data. You can also request the correction of incorrect data.

In addition, under certain conditions, you have the right to have data deleted, the right to restrict data processing and the right to data portability.

Your data is processed on the basis of legal regulations. We only need your consent in exceptional cases. In these cases, you have the right to withdraw your consent for future processing.

You also have the right to complain to the responsible data protection supervisory authority if you believe that the processing of your personal data is not lawful.
